THE PROBLEM

Despite decades of effort and trillions of dollars spent, health disparities in East and Southern Africa persist due to complex, intersecting challenges largely driven by HIV/AIDS and WASH. The path to lasting change lies with these very communities, whose knowledge, resilience, and innovation are key to long-lasting transformation. However, only 14% of funding from international donors goes to local organizations in Africa, so an astounding 86% of funding never gets into the hands of those closest to the issues being addressed. Many local leaders and community-based organizations are implementing solutions that drive lasting change, but remain under-resourced and under-funded.

We find, vet and partner with growth stage organizations, leveraging our trusted networks across the continent. We prioritize organizations on the fringes of the funding ecosystem whose work is evidencing change.

We commit to an **eight-year partnership**, providing **organizational strengthening investments ("OS")** paired with **flexible funding** to advance **community resilience and health.**



Partner Strengthening

We dedicate resources to strengthen partners holistically, applying a proven approach that considers both the individual organization and the entire community of partners at the same time.

An **individualized**, partner-driven assessment is conducted empowering partners to **identify and action their health priorities**. This iterative process offers consensus-based reflection and casts vision in two-year intervals, with dedicated funding to invest accordingly.

Concurrently, Blood:Water facilitates *The Leader Collective*, a vibrant community of practice with a curated menu of in-person and virtual organizational strengthening offerings which respond to **shared learning interests**. It also showcases partner expertise through publishing and co-creating of resources including technical briefs, webinars and peer-exchanges.

Deployed as an online platform in 2024, The Leader Collective's membership will be open to other aligned organizations, amplifying the power of community to fuel learning and collaboration across the African continent.



The Leader Collective is a **community of practice** that exists to convene, cultivate, and amplify African leadership driving health, development and social change. It embodies our expanding definition of community and a long-term commitment to collaboration, which extends well beyond our grant-partners.

MEASURING SUCCESS

Our approach demonstrates success as organizations experience greater missional efficacy, grow their resource base and provide authentically community-driven solutions that improve health outcomes. We monitor qualitative and quantitative metrics that measure:

- Increased autonomy in shaping their vision and mission, with full ownership of their direction and impact.
- Programs that remain responsive to community needs and are driven by evidence and learning.
- An increasingly diverse pool of funding with longterm commitments to more sustainably resource community-owned solutions.
- + They own their expertise and confidently influence the future of development practice.

THE OPPORTUNITY

Blood:Water provides a pathway for private philanthropy to **move resources quickly** to local organizations for **sustainable** and **compounding impact.** We've positioned over \$32 million dollars to frontline organizations serving communities across 12 countries to date.

Every eight years, Blood:Water will strengthen up to **40 local partners**, directly impacting nearly **14 million people.**

We are seeking new partners to join us as we **scale our impact** to more than double our partnership reach in the wake of the devastated losses of bilateral health commitments. This investment will:

- + Accelerate our reach to more local organizations doing transformative work in their communities. We do the hard work of finding partners doing incredible work despite being obscure and under-resourced.
- **+ Exponentially improve** community health outcomes and organizational resilience for local partners across East and Southern Africa, through a proven model with evidence of results.
- **+ Advance the growth of The Leader Collective** by harnessing the power of community to fuel learning and collaboration across the African continent.


We are responding to the changing landscape by scaling our model to accelerate community access to health funding.

Below is an illustration of our partnerships reach to local partners, both active and historical since 2004.




IMPACT PARTNERS & COLLABORATORS
